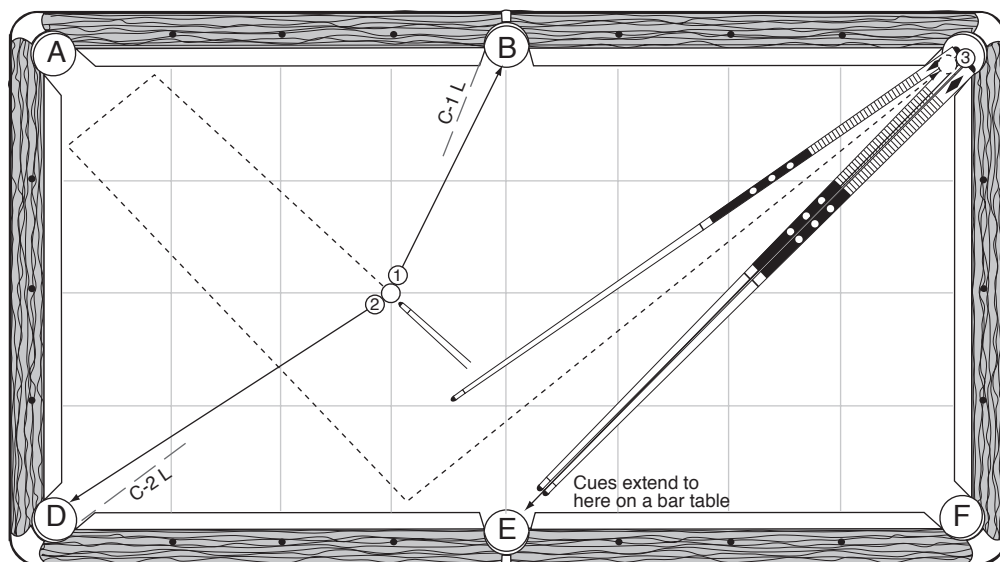
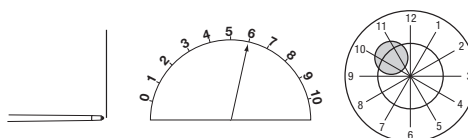


Bar Table Railroad Shot

When I'm giving an exhibition on a bar table and I get a request for a railroad shot, I use this shot. I specially created this shot for the 3.5' x 7' tables because standard length cues are too long for the previous versions. You can, of course, also play this shot on a regulation table.

Place the cues as diagrammed. Balance the 3-ball between the open cue and the one next to it. Make sure the cue ball, 1-ball, and 2-ball are frozen. You will have to allow for a lot of throw when lining up both object balls because of the left english. You'll also need to shoot a little harder so the cue ball will dislodge the 3-ball and knock it onto the right set of tracks.
